- Each nominating organisation must be a not-for-profit voluntary organisation or project but need not be a member of Volunteering Canterbury.
- Only ONE nomination will be accepted from each organisation or project.
- We have three nomination categories: individual, team and youth (19 years and under).
- You may nominate an individual OR group of volunteers for work within your organisation only. This work must have been carried out within Canterbury.
- An individual or group who has received a Volunteering Canterbury Award may not be nominated for an award by the same organisation during the following two years.
- This nomination form must be signed by someone who is not a nominee.
