AND CLICK CHUNKY

Crochet



SIRDAR

in	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
cm	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10

For Aran weight	5.00 hook.
Chunky weight	6.00 hook.

2nd Rd. * 4ch, miss 1 dc, 1dc into next dc, rep from * to

3rd Rd. S/s into 1st ch-sp, *
2ch, 4 tr into 4ch sp, 2ch, s/s
into same 4 ch-sp, s/s into
next ch-sp, rep to end, ending
last s/s into 1 st s/s.

4th Rd. * 4ch, working behind petals made on previous rounds, 1dc around base of dc on 2nd rd, rep

5th Rd. * 3ch, 5 dtr into 4ch-sp, 3ch, s/s into same 4 ch-sp, s/s into next 4 ch-sp, rep from * to end, ending last s/s into 1st s/s of 1st petal made on previous rd. Fasten off, leaving long enough end to tie on a tree!

Totally Loopy Flower

UK terms

Materials

Double knit yarn in three colours of your choice

4mm crochet hook

Size

3 ¾ inches diameter

Instructions

4mm crochet hook. DK yarn

Make a magic circle.

Row 1: With Colour A:

10 tr in magic circle. Close circle by pulling on yarn tail. Join with slip stitch in Colour B. Pull yarn tail tightly.

Row 2: With Colour B:

1 ch. 2 dc in each stitch. Join with slip stitch in Colour C. (20 stitches)

Row 3: With Colour C:

(9 ch. 1 dc in same stitch. Slip stitch into next stitch)*. Repeat * around the flower to last stitch.

9 ch. 1 dc in same stitch. Slip stitch into base of first loop.

Finish off and weave in ends.

NB. When changing colour and starting a new row, ensure you pull the new colour through on the very last pull-through of the previous row to prevent the previous colour bleeding into the new row.

US terms

Materials

Double knit yarn in three colours of your choice

4mm crochet hook

Size

3 ¾ inches diameter

Instructions

Body: 4mm crochet hook. DK yarn

Make a magic circle.

Row 1: With Colour A:

10 dc in magic circle. Close circle by pulling on yarn tail. Join with slip stitch in Colour B. Pull yarn tail tightly.

Row 2: With Colour B:

1 ch. 2 sc in each stitch. Join with slip stitch in Colour C. (20 stitches)

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
